In law school, Reagan was on the board of editors for the *Journal of Public Law and Policy* and received several academic honors, including CALI Awards in International Commercial Arbitration, Commercial Law-Payment Systems, and Theories of Conflict. She received the Student Bar Association Trust Scholarship, the BARBRI-Bar Scholarship, and was on the Dean's Honor Roll

multiple times. She received the Public Service Award for her pro-bono work in the community. Reagan was also selected to compete on Hamline's Willem C. Vis International Arbitration Moot Court Team, held annually in Vienna, Austria, where she and her teammates advanced to the top 32 of over 300 teams from law schools around the world. She received an Honorable Mention for the Frédéric Eisemann Award in Team Orals.

In 2013, Reagan received a fellowship at the ADR Centre in Rome, Italy, for a study commissioned by the European Union regarding the Mediation Directive. She co-authored the published study, which has been presented to the European Union and several European parliaments since 2013.

Since 2015, Reagan has judged written brief submissions for the Vis Arbitration Moot and has acted as a judge/arbitrator at the Vis Moot, including in the elimination rounds. Reagan has also assisted several international Universities' Vis International Arbitration Moot teams. Since 2016, Reagan has held Member status with the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, based in London, England.
